Objective

The Church of Eleven22 School of Ministry Internship Program is a comprehensive, two-year leadership development program equipping and training individuals called to full-time ministry for a lifetime of ministry effectiveness.

Key Responsibilities

- Attend 1825 Leadership Team meetings first and third Tuesdays (2 hours)
- Meet with ministry area direct report every week (1 hour)
- Recruit, develop and coordinate serve staff as assigned (3 hours)
- Assist in weekly administrative responsibilities involving the 1825 ministry (6 hours)
- Assist with 1825 social media (2 hours)
- Complete tasks assigned by ministry area direct report, including projects to improve the ministry (5 hours)
- Attend weekly classroom training and complete required readings and assignments (2 hours)
- Attend bi-weekly meeting with your intern coach (3 hours)
- Attend "All Staff" meeting (entire church staff) every Tuesday (1 hour)
