Share Wins, Praises and Prayers: Where did you see God move this week?

The Point: Wisdom in this life is doing what the Good Shepherd tells us to do.

SERMON TEXT: Proverbs 1:1-7, 14:27, 19:23; Psalm 25:14, 33:8; John 10:1-18

Discussion Questions

LEADERS: There is no pressure to get through all the questions; we suggest prayerfully planning your choices for your group. Your leadership of sharing and questioning will determine how deep your group goes with each question.

During this series we will have videos with stories of people living the abundant life. Please show them at the beginning of your disciple group each week. <u>Week 1 Video.</u>

- What stood out to you in the sermon this week?
- What did God reveal to you in the Scriptures (Proverbs 1:1-7) this week, maybe for the first time?

Review and discuss the following questions from pages 78-79 in the Abundant Life Journal that was passed out during service:

- In Proverbs 1:7, the author talks about fearing the Lord. What does fearing the Lord mean? What does it tell us about God's character? (*Hint: Read Proverbs 14:27, Proverbs 19:23, Psalm 25:14, and Psalm 33:8. Fear of the LORD means deep reverence, not being afraid. Pastor Joby referenced the youngest sister, Lucy Pevensie, talking to Mr. Beaver in The Lion, The Witch, and the Wardrobe. Lucy: "IS he safe?" Mr. Beaver: "Safe? Lord no. Who said anything about being safe? But He is good.")*
- If wisdom in this life is doing what the Good Shepherd tells you to do, what needs to change in your life to take this more seriously?
- If every step of obedience leads to life and every step of disobedience leads to death and destruction how does this impact the way you view decisions in your life?
- Discover: How does Proverbs define wisdom? (Wisdom = living in God's world God's way. Wisdom put on flesh and dwelt among us.)
 Deepen: Read John 1:1-14. With this in mind, how does Proverbs point us to the good news of the Gospel? (Proverbs points us to wisdom and Jesus is wisdom. God didn't look down and say, "Listen, you've got an enemy that wants to steal kill and destroy you, and I hope you make wise choices. I hope you can figure this out." Jesus, the King of Glory stands up off his throne, takes off his crown, dresses himself in humanity and swan dives to earth 2,000 years ago to die in our place so we have the capacity to receive and walk in wisdom with the Holy Spirit.)

Direction, <u>NOT</u> intention determines our destination.

 Discover: How do we determine the right path? (Are you listening for and obeying the voice of the Good Shepherd? Get into His Word, spend time praying and obey when you hear His voice. The more you do that, the easier it will be to continue to hear Him and discern the right path.)
 Deepen: Where in your life is your direction not aligned with your intentions and what can you do today to change that?


ACTION STEP

- 1. As we continue in the 10:10 Life discipleship journey, reflect on the commitment you made at the beginning of the journey. What has God done in you and through you?
