SERMON TEXT: John 15:12-15; Genesis 1:1-31, 2:18, 20:26-27; Proverbs 3:27-29, 4:14-15, 8:35-36, 11:25, 13:20, 14:7, 18:2, 22:24-25, 23:19-21, 24:21-22, 25:17, 26:20

Discussion Questions

LEADERS: There is no pressure to get through all the questions; we suggest prayerfully planning your choices for your group. Your leadership of sharing and questioning will determine how deep your group goes with each question.

During this series we will have videos with stories of people living the abundant life. Please show them at the beginning of your disciple group each week. <u>Week 2 Video.</u>

- What stood out to you in the sermon this week?
- What did God reveal to you in the Scriptures (John 15:15) this week, maybe for the first time?

Review and discuss the following questions from page 92 in the Abundant Life Journal that was passed out during service:

- Why is it so profound when Jesus calls us "friends?"
- How have you experienced Jesus's friendship? How have you experienced it through the body of believers?
- What needs to change for you to have close friendships with wise, godly people?
- Share a time you felt lonely and a time you felt connected in deep friendships with others. What made the difference and how did that impact your life?
- Discover: What are the friendship qualities that Proverbs says we should seek out and avoid? (Seek out people who are: safe, 3:29, loyal, 26:20 generous, 3:27-28, 11:25, have healthy boundaries, 25:17, 8:35-36, love Jesus, John 15:12-15. Avoid people who are: wicked, 4:14-15, foolish 14:7, 13:20, 18:2, quick to anger, 22:24-25, given to excess, 23:19-21, perpetually discontented, 24:21-22.)

 Deepen: How does the Holy Spirit help us intentionally practice or avoid these qualities in our friendships?
- Discover: God redeems broken things and He almost always uses people to do it. Who has God used in your life to help your loneliness and brokenness?
 Deepen: If God has a plan to use you to help someone with their loneliness and brokenness, who would that be? Consider how God might be calling you to act in a redemptive way.

ACTION STEP

A Disciple...Loves All People, Discovers Identity in Jesus, Deepens Relationship with Jesus


Family Time
