Share Wins, Praises and Prayers: Where did you see God move this week?

The Point: Are you ready to do what Jesus did? "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!"

Sermon Text: Psalm 31; Matthew 26:36-39; Luke 23:44-49; John 5:19-29, 10:14-18; Philippians 2:5-11

Discussion Questions

eternal life.

LEADERS: There is no pressure to get through all the questions; we suggest prayerfully planning your choices for your group. Your leadership of sharing and questioning will determine how deep your group goes with each question.

- Read *John 5:19-29* and *Luke 23:44-49*. What stood out to you in the sermon this week and what did God reveal to you in the Scriptures, maybe for the first time?
- Christ was committed from the beginning, and eternally, to God's plan to redeem you through the cross (*Luke 23:44-47*). How does that challenge you to submit and commit everything to Jesus and share the Gospel with others? (*This was not a one time or final decision from Jesus. He has been eternally submitted and committed to the plan of the Father. Jesus voluntarily shed his blood and died on the cross to save you! That demands a response from you.)*
- What does it mean to bow to Him now as Savior or bow to Him later as Judge (Philippians 2:5-11)?
 (You can bow to Him as Savior now and be lifted up. You can have a relationship with Him, the abundant life and eternity with Him in Heaven. Or you can bow later, on judgement day, and be eternally separated from God.)
- Read John 5:23.

 Discover: Why do you think it's so controversial today for Jesus to have said, "Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him"? (Jesus claimed to be the Son of God and to be the only way to the Father. That is not popular with those who believe all roads lead to heaven.)

 Deepen: Share how you would explain to a non-believer why Jesus is the only way to salvation and
- Matthew 26:39 says, "And going a little farther he fell on his face and prayed, saying, 'My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will." Where in your life do you need to pray, "Father, into to your hands I commit _____. Not as I will, but as you will."? (If you can't share this with the entire group right now, who can you share it with? Commit to praying this every day. There is a difference between having your spirit committed into the hands of the Father and having your LIFE committed into the hands of the Father.)
- Read *Psalm 31*. *Discover:* Why is it important that on the cross Jesus changed the quote "into your hands I commit my spirit," from Psalm 31:5, to "into my Father's hands I commit my Spirit," in Luke 23:46? (Jesus was claiming to be the Son of God and he wants us to know God as our heavenly Father.) *Deepen:* How does that affect your relationship with God?


