Share Wins, Praises and Prayers: Where did you see God move this week?

The Point: When Jesus says, "follow me," He isn't offering at second chance at life. He is offering a NEW LIFE...HIS LIFE.

Sermon Text: Mark 1:16-17; John 21; Acts 4:19; 1 Peter 4:12-14

Discussion Questions

Leaders: Save 5-10 minutes for the in-group action step. The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. It's ok if you don't cover every question.

Action step check in/follow up from last week: How did it go? What did you learn about God? About yourself?

- Read *John 21.* What stood out to you in the sermon this week and what did God reveal to you in the Scriptures, maybe for the first time?
- After Jesus died, Peter returned to his old way of life fishing.
 Discover: What do you return to when life or your walk with Jesus doesn't go like you want it to?
 Deepen: How do you return to Jesus?
- There is more grace in Jesus than sin in you. He will never stop pursuing you. *Discover:* What makes you question that? (Sin. The lies and whispers of the enemy. What we may have heard from friends, family, our culture, etc. Peter denied Jesus three times, but Jesus still sought him out to forgive him and to use him for the Kingdom. The entire Bible shows countless examples of God giving grace to cover every type of sin.)

Deepen: Share how you respond to someone who says, "I can't be forgiven, you don't know what I've done!" This could be your testimony of how God showed you His grace is sufficient when you felt unforgiveable


- Why does Jesus ask Peter, "Do you love me?" instead of "Are you going to try harder and do better next time?" (We don't need a second chance; we'll just blow it again. We need a Savior. Pastor Jim Bergen said, "There are no second chances. There is the blood of Jesus and from now on." We love Jesus because he first loved us, and out of our love for Him we want to obey His commands, and He helps us obey. Abiding in Jesus and loving Him changes us from the inside out, sets us free and changes everything. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-5 and Matthew 22:36-38.)
- In Group Action Step: At the beginning and end of His ministry, Jesus says to Peter, "Follow me." Spend five minutes of group time right now praying and writing down the answers to these two questions: 1. What is God calling you to do right now? 2. What's stopping you from doing it? If anyone wants to share their answers, please do.
