**The Point:** Jesus came to save sinners. All have sinned. No one is so good that they don't need a savior. See Paul. No one is so bad that they can't be saved. See Paul.

Sermon Text: Psalm 1:1-2; 19:7-11; Acts 8:9-20; Philippians 3:2-10; Galatians 3:21; 1 Timothy 1:8-17

<u>Action Step</u> Start a daily Bible reading plan today and see how the word of God conforms you to the likeness of Jesus Christ. Report back to the group next week on what you're experiencing.

## **Discussion Questions**

**Leaders:** The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. **It's ok if you don't cover every question.** 

- Read 1 Timothy 1:8-17. What stood out to you in the sermon this week and what did God reveal to you in the Scriptures, maybe for the first time?
- Read Psalm 1:1-2 and 19:7-11. What do you think about when you think about God's Law and the entire Bible? (God's law is described in the commands, statutes, and ordinances in the Bible. It's good, perfect, pure, true and sweeter than honey. The Bible is the inerrant, inspired Word of God not just a book of inspiration for you. We must use God's Word as He intended NOT to beat people up or as binoculars to look at others' sins. Used correctly, it assists you in knowing God and deepening your relationship with Jesus.)
- How is the Bible a map and a mirror? (It's a map to show you how to rightly live with a righteous God. It's
  a mirror to show you're a sinner, that it's impossible for you to live rightly and you need a savior, Jesus
  Christ.)
- Read 1 Timothy 1:8-11. When and how did you realize that "we are all on the list" of sinners?
- Read Philippians 3:2-10 and 1 Timothy 1:12-13. Many people (even many Christians) believe that if you're a "good" person you go to heaven.
  Discover: How would you explain that no one is good, and no one gets into heaven by being good?
  (Speak the truth in Love. Use Matthew 5 to show that the way Jesus describes the 10 commandments we've all broken ALL of them. By the biblical definition of "good," there has only been ONE good person Jesus. See Romans 3:23. The only way to have your sins washed away is by the blood of Jesus.)
  Deepen: How does the realization that no one is good help you avoid judging others?
- It can be difficult to believe that no one is so good that they don't need a savior and no one is so bad that they can't be saved. What do you do to wrestle with, and rest in, these truths?
- How can you increase your pursuit of, and delight in, God's Word?


