**Sermon Text:** Luke 9:22; 18:31-35; 24; John 10:10; 14:6; 1 John 2:15

<u>Action Step</u> Begin your prayer time every day this week by saying out loud: "If the tomb is empty, anything is possible." Then ask Jesus to fill you with His peace, presence and purpose to help you live from resurrection power, not your own striving.

## **Discussion Questions**

**Leaders:** The goal is to grow in our relationship with Christ and each other. *It's ok if you don't cover every question.* 

- Read *Luke 24.* What stood out to you in the sermon this week and what did God reveal to you in the Scriptures, maybe for the first time?
- What makes Easter the most important event in history?
- What do you consider to be the most life-changing moment in your life?
- We are ALL sinners like Barabbas. Jesus died to set us free. Share what that says about you and about God's character.
- Jesus said, "It is finished." How would you explain to someone what was finished on the cross?
- Discover: Read Luke 24:5-6. Where are you looking for LIFE where there is no life? (We are all on a happiness, meaning, purpose, fulfillment LIFE quest and the things of this world cannot provide what we're looking for. Read 1 John 2:15-17. Jesus is the fulfillment of the desire of the flesh—peace; the desires of the eyes—an eternal reward that will never fade; and the pride of life—a son or daughter of the Most High King.)


**Deepen:** Share how you turn to Jesus and the Holy Spirit to look for true life. (See John 10:10; 14:26; Acts 1:8; Romans 8:14; 1 John 1:5-10;)

Discover: After his resurrection, Jesus continued to pursue His people. He's still pursuing us today. What does that say about God's love for you?
Deepen: Share how God is pursuing you and how you respond to it.
