Apprenticeship Description:

The summer students apprenticeship is an immersive, hands-on ministry training experience designed for high school students exploring a potential calling to student ministry. It will focus on building middle school environments and discipling middle school students towards discovering and deepening their relationship with Jesus. Apprentices will gain practical ministry experience, mentorship and theological development while serving alongside the Central Students team.

Apprenticeship Goal:

The apprenticeship goal is to invest in our next generation of movement leaders by helping them discover and deepen a potential calling to ministry by reaching and discipling middle school students through an immersive summer experience.

Apprentice Responsibilities:

- Lead Summer Family Group for middle school students
- Assist the Central Students ministry team
- Assist in planning and executing Middle School Camp
- Disciple middle school students
- Participate in weekly mentorship opportunities and School of Ministry classes

- Must be a high school student leader who demonstrates a growing and mature relationship with Jesus Christ
