Sermon Text: *1 Kings 17:8-16; Psalm 16:5-6; 37:3-5; Isaiah 45:2-3; Matthew 6:19-33; Romans 8:28*

Action Step: What is God calling you to do that you're not doing? Pray on it, then obey God and do it. Share it with your group in your group chat or at group next week.

Discussion Questions

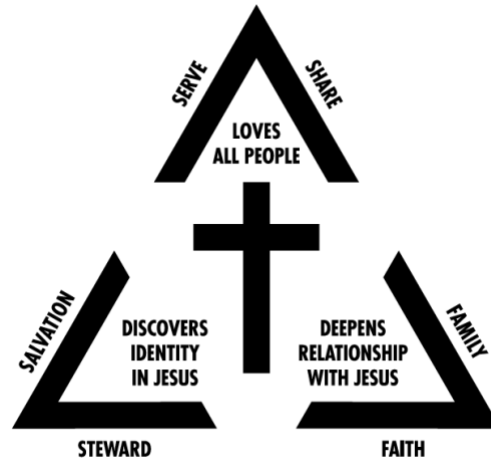
Leaders: Our goal is for your group members to engage in a meaningful discussion, not to answer every question. Creating trust among members and understanding who is in the group is vital to taking conversations deeper and growing in vulnerability.

- **Read 1 Kings 17:8-16. What stood out to you in the sermon this week and what did God reveal to you in the Scriptures?**
- **Discover:** On a scale of 1 to 10, how much of a "green light" follower are you when God says go? *(Remember, when God calls you to go: It's for good reason. It's going to be uncomfortable. You should be prepared to stay where He sends you. He goes before you. He will take care of you. The Lord God of Israel has a word for you. Will you trust him?)*
Deepen: What tends to make you hesitate when you know God is telling you to go?
- **Discover:** Discuss possible reasons God used the poor widow/mother to provide for Elijah. *(God's kingdom is an upside down kingdom. He frequently uses those the world considers poor, weak, insignificant or even useless to do His work, for His glory. The widow was a gentile and yet she showed more faith than the Jews who had turned away from God. God's provision for a gentile widow and her son showed His love went beyond Israel.)*
Deepen: What do we learn about God in the account of Elijah and the widow? *(He sees us — the widow had given up and God sends the most renowned prophet with a word. He is trustworthy — God's words delivered by Elijah came true. God often teaches us in uncomfortable ways.)*
- **Discover:** Why do you think God often asks us to trust Him when we feel we have nothing to spare?
Deepen: Share a time you only had a little, trusted God with it and saw Him provide and multiply it.
- **What steps can you take this week to grow your trust in God even when His commands seem unclear or challenging?** *(Remember all God has done for you in the past. Pray for God to restore your trust in Him alone. Pray for the faith to believe Romans 8:28, "And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.")*
