Share Wins, Praises and Prayers: Where did you see God move this week?

Action Step Review: Last week's in-group action step: *"Right now, spend five minutes finding a Psalm that you turn to when you need to go in the presence of Jesus? Some examples are Psalm 13, 22 and 42. You can do an Internet search on "psalms of _____." (Sharing your own "laments" with God will strengthen your daily walk with Him.)"* How did God answer your prayers? What did you learn about God? About yourself?

Sermon Text: 1 Samuel 16:7; Psalm 145; Matthew 13:44; Luke 12:7; 16:15

Discussion Questions

Leaders: Our goal is for your group members to engage in a meaningful discussion, not to answer every question. Creating trust among members and understanding who is in the group is vital to taking conversations deeper and growing in vulnerability.

- **Read the lyrics or listen to *How Great Thou Art*. You can listen on Eleven22's HYMNS album on *Spotify, Apple Music, YouTube Music, or Amazon Music*. What stood out to you in the sermon this week, in the Scriptures and what God revealed to you about Himself?**
- **What are the parallels between Psalm 145 & the lyrics of *How Great Thou Art*?**
- **Carl Boberg was on his way home from church, focused on God, saw the glorious splendor of His majesty in a thunderstorm and wrote, *How Great Thou Art*. Share a time when your attention towards God helped you see Him and a time your busyness, inattention, temptations, etc. prevented you from seeing and feeling God.**
- **Discuss the four ingredients of God-honoring, Christ-exalting, war-making worship. (*It's personal, surrendered, it's generational & it's grateful.*)**
- **Share a time when God personally revealed to you how greatly He loves you. (*God wants you to know how much He loves you, values you and how well He knows you. See Luke 12:7. We were made to be loved by God and to love God. God takes you personally.*)**
- **God is again using the younger generation to start another awakening. How can you disciple, encourage and support the next generation in what God is calling them to do? (See Psalm 145:4.)**
- **Pastor Britt shared about the lawless border lands between Kenya & Uganda. How do you get stuck in the borderland, between two ways of life? (*Once God saves you, He begins to transform you. Sometimes you don't like how God is pruning you, so you hold on to unhealthy things you like/think are good. You can lose trust in God and develop the illusion of self-control.*)**
- **Why should we be grateful to God? (*God is holy, good, perfect, full of grace and mercy and worthy of grateful worship. God is the greatest gift of all. All good gifts come from Him. Being grateful to God draws us closer to Him and brings us His joy. We can also be grateful for difficult, even crushing times that God uses to transform us and make us more like Christ.*)**

Action Step: If you made your gratitude list already, share something from it with your group right now. If you haven't made your list yet, do it this week and then share something with your group.
