Share Wins, Praises and Prayers: Where did you see God move this week?

Action Step Review: Last week’s in-group action step: *“Pray Psalm 139:23-24, that the Holy Spirit will reveal to you any thing or any sin that is making you prone to wander. Then, every day this week pray Psalm 51.”* How did God answer your prayers? What did you learn about God? About yourself?

Sermon Text: *1 Chronicles 17:16-17; Luke 15; 19:10; Romans 3:11; 6:1; 1 Corinthians 1:1-10; 2 Corinthians 9:8; 9:14; 11:5; Galatians 1:15; Ephesians 1:6-7; 2:8-9; 3:7-8; 1 Timothy 1:14; Hebrews 13:8; James 4:5; Revelation 22:21*

Discussion Questions

Leaders: Our goal is for your group members to engage in a meaningful discussion, not to answer every question. Creating trust among members and understanding who is in the group is vital to taking conversations deeper and growing in vulnerability.

- Read the lyrics or listen to **Amazing Grace**. Which lines comfort or encourage you?
- What stood out to you in the sermon this week, in the Scriptures and what God revealed to you about Himself? (You can listen on Eleven22's HYMNS album on Spotify, Apple Music, YouTube Music, or Amazon Music.)
- How has your understanding and approach to worship changed over this sermon series?
- Discuss what's so amazing about grace. (*Leaders, here are some points to help the discussion: Grace is amazing because it originates with and belongs to God and it's rooted in God's character. God by his grace goes first. He does the seeking and the finding. Grace is the unearned, undeserved, ill-deserved, lavish gift of God. Grace is why we have everything good in life. God's grace does the saving and it's the power for any feeling and faith we have in Jesus. Grace is so amazing because by grace God provides everything we need and sustains and keeps us all the way to the end. See 1 Corinthians 1:8–9.*)
- Read: Ephesians 2:8–9 and Romans 3:24. What does it mean that grace is “from God” and “of God”?
- Read: Luke 19:10; Romans 3:11. Pastor Flynt said, “We don't find God—God finds us.” Share how you've personally experienced God's seeking grace.
- What is “cheap” grace? (*When you take advantage of grace by sinning without repentance or remorse – thinking you have a license to sin. Jesus did not give his life for cheap grace.*)
- How do you know grace is true and for you? (*Before grace is a “what”, it's a “who.” Jesus on the cross paid it - “It is finished.” The resurrection of Jesus authenticates it.*)
- **Discover:** “How precious did that grace appear the hour I first believed.” Share how grace appeared when you first believed that Jesus Christ died for you.
Deepen: Take five minutes right now and write down where you're struggling to trust in the grace given to you by the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Share what you feel called to share.
- How would you describe and explain God's grace to someone who has never experienced it?
- How can you approach and respond to the people in your life with grace, more than judgment or correction, like Paul did in his letters to the churches?

Action Step: During your God time this week listen to Amazing Grace and focus your prayers on thanking Jesus for His grace in your life.
