**Sermon Text:** *Psalm 16:11; Isaiah 62:5; Matthew 25:1; 1 Corinthians 15:42–49; Revelation 19:7-9; 21:1-8; 22:4-20*

## Discussion Questions

**Leaders:** Please use the questions in the curriculum to facilitate discussion of the sermon and the Scriptures. But there's no need to answer every question. The goal is to get your group members talking more than you.

- **Read Revelation 21:1-8. What stood out to you this week in the sermon, in the Scriptures and what God revealed to you about Himself?**
- **How are Christmas and the book of Revelation related?** *(There are two sides of Christmas. One is Jesus coming to earth as a baby, the other is Jesus coming again to earth as king forever. So, we need to talk about where Christmas is ultimately headed: Jesus coming again. CS Lewis said, "Those who think the most about the next life, do the most good in this life.")*
- **Discover:** Discuss what you thought heaven was going to be like and where you got your ideas from. **Deepen:** Discuss what you think the New Heaven and the New Earth are going to be like after hearing Pastor Flynt's sermon and reading Revelation 21:1-8. *(Some things to imagine: Purposeful, fulfilling work without the curse from our sin. Perfect, resurrected bodies. No temptation, sin, Satan, or demons. Nothing ever breaks or wears out. No sickness, tiredness or broken bones. Perfect food, sunrises and temperature. Everything working exactly as God designed.)*
- **How has your view of eternity shaped the way you live? In what ways might an incomplete or inaccurate view of eternity affect your priorities, fears, or faithfulness?**
- **Read Revelation 21:1 and Isaiah 9:6. Pastor Adam explained that "the sea" symbolizes chaos and danger. What areas of your life feel like the sea right now, and how does God's promise of total peace speak to those fears?** *(God promises a future without turmoil, anxiety or fear where the Prince of Peace fully reigns and chaos cannot exist.)*
- **Read Revelation 21:3-4. What does this tell you about the Character of God and the relationship you will have with Him?** *(It's not that we will be with God, but God will be with us. The whole Bible is about God coming to be with us, not how we can work to go up to him.)*
- **Read Rev 21:2, Revelation 19:7-9, Isaiah 62:5 and Ephesians 5:25–27. Why do you think God uses the symbolic imagery of a bride prepared for her husband to describe eternity and what does that say about how He feels about you?** *(It shows that eternity is not just about location, but relationship. God delights in His people with joy, love, and deep personal affection.)*
- **Read Revelation 21:8. What does the Bible say about Hell?** *("The lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death" is eternal, conscious torment in hell, out of any of the peace, perfection, presence, and joy of God. There are no good people in the new heaven and new earth, only forgiven people. Our works, behavior, or morals don't earn us the way there – only our faith in Jesus.)*
- **If you truly believe the New Heaven and New Earth is your guaranteed future in Christ, what do you need to change about how you spend your time, how you love God and love people?**

**Action Step:** Every day this week, intentionally thank Jesus for one promise from Revelation 21. Then look for opportunities to encourage someone else with the hope of what Jesus is making new.
